*Paeonia lactiflora*

This award-winning peony features large, semi-double blooms with coral-colored petals that fade to ivory. Though peonies will not bloom the first year and may take up to two years to fully mature, the showy and fragrant blooms are well worth the wait!

**Plant Type:** Perennial

**Bloom Time:** Late spring to early summer

**Advantages:** Deer resistant; bee and butterfly attractor; great for cut arrangements

**Advantages:** Deer resistant; bee and butterfly attractor; great for cut arrangements





**Advantages:** Excellent in cut arrangements; butterfly attractor



### Pompon Dahlia (3)

#### *Dahlia*





### Thomas Edison Dahlia (3)

#### *Dahlia*

The deep purple blossoms of this dinner plate dahlia look stunning in bouquets as well as garden borders. Choose a sunny but sheltered location to protect from wind. In hot southern climates, some afternoon shade is desirable.

**Plant Type:** Perennial in zones 8–11; dig up and store over winter in zones 3–7

**Bloom Time:** Midsummer through fall

**Advantages:** Butterfly attractor; great for

borders and cut arrangements

**Mature Plant Size:** Approx. 36"–48" tall

**Light Requirements:** Full sun

**Plant Depth:** 4"–6" deep, 12"–18" apart

**Soil Type:** Sandy or loamy soil

### Columbine (5)

*Aquilegia*

This hardy, shade-loving flower has unique, star-shaped petals. For cut arrangements, pick when blooms are only half-open.

### Torch Lily (3)

*Kniphofia*

The bright orange blooms of this stately, tropical-looking plant grow on stalks up to 4 feet tall and are a favorite of pollinators.

**Bloom Time:** Early to late summer

**Advantages:** Deer resistant; attracts butterflies and hummingbirds

### Mixed Yarrow (3)

*Achillea*





## Freesia Mix (20)

*Freesia*

**Bloom Time:** Late spring to midsummer


**Advantages:** Easy to grow; great for containers and cut flowers

## Butterfly Weed (5)

## Crocosmia Mix (5)

*Crocosmia*

Sprays of colorful flowers bloom along graceful stems. Once established, it's a prolific bloomer!

## Rainbow Gladiolus Mix (40)

### Gladiolus

Enjoy a summer cutting garden full of showy blooms! Plant a large number of bulbs grouped together for a dramatic effect. We recommend choosing a spot sheltered from wind to avoid staking. In zones 3–7, dig up bulbs to store indoors for winter.

**Hardiness Zones:** 8–11

**Plant Type:** Perennial in zones 8–11; dig up and store over winter in zones 3–7



**Bloom Time:** Early summer

**Advantages:** Cut arrangements; butterfly and hummingbird attractor

**Mature Plant Size:** Approx. 12"–24" tall

**Light Requirements:** Full sun

## Summer Sun Garden Mix (80)

*Lilium, Freesia, Gladiolus nanus, Liatris*

Fill up a flowerbed with this collection of sun-loving summer bloomers! Attract pollinators to your garden or create beautiful cut arrangements. Set includes 10 Golden Yellow Lily, 20 Freesia Mix, 20 Hardy Gladiolus Mix, and 30 Blazing Star for a total of 80 bulbs (shown clockwise from upper right).

**Hardiness Zones:** 5–8

**Plant Type:** Lily, hardy gladiolus, and blazing star are perennial; freesia is annual in most zones, perennial in zones 9–10

## Pollinator Garden Collection (17)

*Kniphofia, Echinacea, Echinops ritro*

Hummingbirds, bees, and butterflies will become frequent visitors

## About Our Bulbs

We source our bulbs directly from Holland. These healthy, hardy, and unique varieties will succeed in various areas throughout the contiguous United States. The larger bulb sizes we offer will maximize the blooms in your garden right from the start.

Know your hardiness zone, and be aware of the recommended hardiness zones for any bulbs you purchase. You can find out your hardiness zone by checking the map on the USDA's website at [plants.usda.gov/hardiness.html](http://plants.usda.gov/hardiness.html). A hardiness zone map is also available on the landing page for the fundraiser you are supporting.

With your bulbs, you will receive an instruction sheet for planting. Bulbs should be planted immediately upon arrival; if the danger of

frost has not passed in your area, you can either store your roots in a cool area for two to three days or plant them in pots indoors until the outside weather warms.

Bulbs that are not hardy to your area will need to be dug up before the first hard frost and stored in a cool, dark, dry location through winter. Winter storage instructions are also provided on the instruction sheet you will receive with your bulb order.
